CURRENT BOOK PROJECT:

Tentative Title. *The Urban Racial State: Programming Race Relations through Community Action*. Goal. In this book project I will explicate a theory of what I refer to as the *urban racial state* through an historical sociological analysis of racial conflict over control of War on Poverty Community Actions Programs in two mid-size northern cities in the 1960s. Status of Work. The data have been collected and cataloged, the basic conceptual and organizational ideas have been formulated, and I am now in the early stage of the process of writing the first draft of the manuscript.
